

MPW makes quick work of facility deep clean



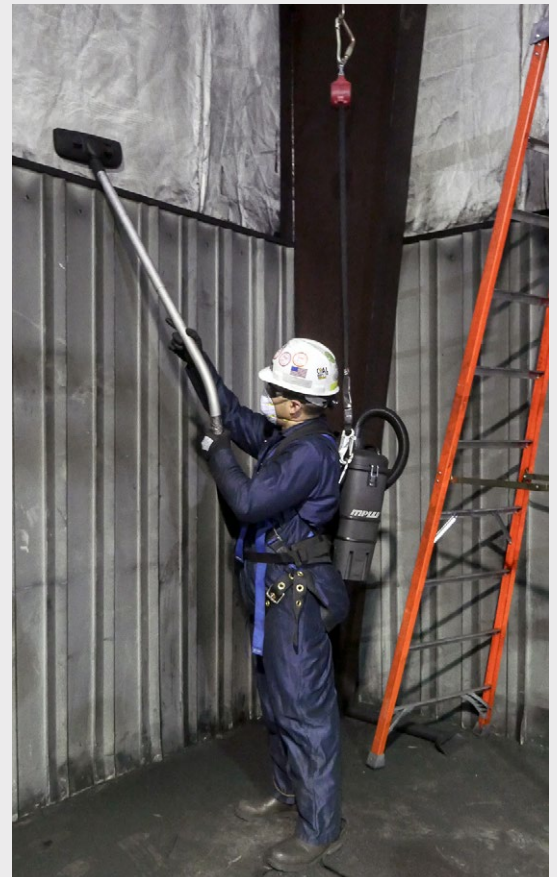
EFFICIENCY KEY TO MINIMIZING LABOR HOURS

A uranium-enrichment plant in the Southwestern United States needed an extensive cleaning before workers could install essential equipment.
