

Confined Space Rescue

Program follows OSHA 29 CFR 1910.146, mandated state, federal programs.

Team members are trained in first aid, CPR, Hazardous Waste Operations, emergency response (HAZWOPER).

Response includes most Imminent Danger to Life and Health (IDLH) situations.



FEATURES

- All team members trained in Confined Space Rescue (per 29 CFR 1910.146 requirement), 40-hour HAZWOPER (per 29 CRF 1910.120) and CPR/AED/first aid
- Confined Space Rescue trailers contain more than 80 pieces of emergencyremediation equipment
- MPW works with you to identify your specific confined space entry and rescue needs
- MPW teams train for vertical or horizontal entry, restricted portals, Immediately Dangerous to Life or Health (IDLH) situations, etc.
